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PROCEEDINGS

THE COURT: Please be seated. Okay. We can bring Mr. Bradley forward. Have him stand at the podium, please.

Mr. Bradley, if you'll come forward and step up at the podium. State your full name for the record, please.

THE DEFENDANT: John F. Dotson.

THE COURT: Okay. I'm going to call you by Bradley because that's the name I know you as.

Mr. Bradley, you are here in case number -- State of Florida versus Brandon Lee Bradley, case number 05-2012-CF-035337-A.

You wrote a letter to the Court, it's dated June -I believe June the 4th, 2012. I received it on June the
12th, 2012. And it appears from that letter that you
are not satisfied with the representation that you're
getting from your attorney, and you specifically
referenced Mr. Moore.

That's the purpose of today's hearing, to address those concerns. Are you asking that I go forward with regard to this matter?

THE DEFENDANT: No.

THE COURT: Okay. When I hear "no," does that mean

-- the purpose of this hearing was to determine whether

you wanted to discharge your Court-appointed attorney.

Do you at this time want the Court to consider that request?

THE DEFENDANT: Okay, you true, I don't trust nothing. They took my crosses, and I know what's going on in this courtroom. Everybody took oaths and I know what that mean. Y'all under the dark one, and that mean that all y'all got spirits working against me. And even if he was my attorney or not, everybody still working against me. C.O.s trying to kill me. I already know what's going on.

THE COURT: Okay. Mr. Bradley, the purpose of today's hearing is to determine whether you want me to address your Court-appointed counsel, and whether you're requesting that your Court-appointed counsel be discharged.

Are you requesting that I go forward with regard to that motion?

THE DEFENDANT: Like I say, he is going to be with me or against me. All y'all are against me.

THE COURT: Okay. I haven't heard a "yes" or a "no." If you want me to go forward, I will address it now. If you do not want me to go forward, then that was the only purpose of the proceedings this afternoon and the hearings are concluded.

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So, there's nothing else set and there's nothing else that I'm going to address this afternoon. Do you want me to go forward with the concerns that you wrote in your letter of June the 4th, 2012?

THE DEFENDANT: No, I'm going to keep him.

THE COURT: Okay. All right. Then at this time, the Public Defender's Office will remain as counsel for the proceedings. The Court's going to -- the Court having inquired whether a Nelson inquiry was necessary and the Defendant having relayed to the Court that such a hearing was not necessary, at this time the request is withdrawn. It is withdrawn without prejudice, Mr. Bradley.

Mr. McMaster?

MR. McMASTER: Judge, just so the record's clear, the State has received two letters from the Court; one dated June 4th, the other one dated June 8th.

THE COURT: Okay. I have not -- you know, now that you say that, I do see also a letter of June 8th.

Mr. Bradley, just to make sure, it appears there's a letter of June 8th. I actually didn't see that until right now. There's a letter of June 8th that also has some concerns with regard to your Court-appointed attorney.

Are you asking me to consider those concerns at RYAN REPORTING

this time? Only addressing the concerns with regard to 1 your Court-appointed attorney. Do you want Mr. Moore to 2 3 continue to represent you in these matters? THE DEFENDANT: Yeah. 5 THE COURT: Okay. Can you answer? I heard a "yeah." Just so the record's clear, and I'm not trying 6 7 to give you a hard time, I'm just trying to make the record clear, can I have a "yes" or a "no"? 8 THE DEFENDANT: Yes. THE COURT: Okay. All right. Thank you. 10 Then, there's nothing else that we need to address 11 with regard to this matter, and this hearing is 12 13 concluded. 14 Okay. Mr. Bradley, you can go with the Court 15 deputies. Thank you, sir. Okay. It appears that all matters that are set for 16 17 this afternoon have been addressed, so Court is in

recess until 8:30 tomorrow morning. Thank you.
