## ORDER ADJUDGING DEFENDANT A PRISON RELEASEE REOFFENDER AS TO COUNTS 1, 2 AND 4

This Cause having come before the Court upon the State's Notice of Intent to Prosecute Defendant as a Prison Releasee Reoffender pursuant to Section 775.082(9), Florida Statutes, and the court having received evidence, heard argument of counsel, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

- 1. The Defendant is convicted in this case of one (or more) of the qualifying offenses set forth in section 775.082(9)(a)1, to wit, subsections: (b) MURDER: (g) ROBBERY; and (o) RESISTING ARREST WITH VIOLENCE.
- 2. The Defendant was last released from a Florida correctional facility operated by the Department of Corrections or a private vendor on MAY 11, 2010.
- 3. The offense(s) for which the Defendant is convicted in this case were committed on MARCH 6, 2012, which is within three years of the Defendant's last release from prison.

It is thereupon **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

1. That the Defendant is a Prison Releasee Reoffender and is sentenced under section 775.082(9)(a).

- 2. The Defendant shall be released only by expiration of sentence and shall not be eligible for parole, control release, or any form of early release.
- 3. The Defendant must serve 100 percent of the sentence imposed by the Court in this case.
