There were six incorporated towns in Brevard County when the first missiles were launched in 1950 and their combined population of 12,320 was slightly more than half of the county's 23,500 inhabitants. The 371 percent increase from 23,500 to 111,435 during the next decade made Brevard the fastest growing county in the nation in the 1950's.
