

IN RE: CANCELLATION OF FORECLOSURE SALE – HURRICANE IRMA

In order to maximize the efficient administration of justice and pursuant to Rule 2.215(b)(2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is thereupon, ORDERED:

1. As a result of the State of Emergency existing in Brevard County due to Hurricane Irma and the closure of the clerk and the courts between Friday, September 8th and Tuesday, September 12th, 2017, the foreclosure sale scheduled for Wednesday, September 13, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. is hereby cancelled.
2. Plaintiff or Plaintiff's counsel shall bear the burden of resetting any foreclosure sale cancelled due to this Administrative Order and shall bear the costs of publication thereof.
