In 1868 the three Hardee brothers, Gardner, A.W., and R.A. arrived in Central Brevard from Georgia. Between them, the brothers owned more than 600 acres that became one of the earliest large citrus groves in what is now the Sharpes area, and included a sawmill and packing house.
