**IN RE:           PROBATE AND GUARDIANSHIP – ESTABLISHING SURETY BONDS FOR  
PUBLIC GUARDIANS**

WHEREAS, Section 744.2102, Florida Statutes (2004) requires that a public guardian file a surety bond in the amount fixed by a majority of judges within each judicial circuit; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the judges within the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit have approved a proposal that the amount of such surety bond shall be \$15,000.00.

It is hereby Ordered and Adjudged that public guardians holding that office under Section 701, et.seq., Florida Statutes in the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit shall file a surety bond with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in the amount of \$15,000.00
