2 THE COURT: Okay. Let's go ahead and do
3 Brandon Bradley.

4 MR. MOORE: Yes, ma'am.

5 THE COURT: Mr. Moore, before we bring him
6 out, can I have a bench conference with the
7 attorneys.

8 (Bench conference took place.)

9 THE COURT: The press is not there. I know
10 that one of your concerns is him being -- no, no, I
11 said, Don't bring him out yet.

12 (End of bench conference.)

13 THE COURT: I said before you bring him out,
14 I want to have a conference with the attorneys.

15 THE BAILIFF: Oh, I'm sorry.

16 THE COURT: So hold on.

17 (Bench conference was held.)

18 THE COURT: Because the press is not here,
19 any objection to handling it in open court with him
20 present?

21 MR. MOORE: Well, no, ma'am. He's going to
22 have to be fingerprinted if the Court grants the
23 motion. We don't object to it.

24 THE COURT: Okay, okay. Just wanted to make
