only to (a) any judge of this Circuit for case-related reasons, (b) the Chief Judge,

Administrative Judge, or their designee, (c) to Plain tiff and Defendant, their

lawful agents, or their attorneys of record, or (d) by further order of the Court.

The Clerk of Court shall post a copy of this Order on the Clerk's website and in a

"prominent public location" in the Brevard County Court house within 10 days of

the rendition of this Order, and the posted copy shall remain there for at least 30

days from the date it is first posted. After the 30th day from the date this Order is

posted and unless further ordered by the Court, the Clerk of Court shall remove

the posted copy of this Order.
