WHEREAS, Florida Statute Sections 741.30 and 784.046 provides that the chief judge of each circuit, in consultation with the appropriate sheriff, may authorize a law enforcement agency within the jurisdiction to effect service; it is thereupon

ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

That after consultation with the Seminole County Sheriff, the chief judge hereby authorizes Oviedo Police Department, Sanford Police Department, Sanford Airport Police Department, Lake Mary Police Department, Winter Springs Police Department, Casselberry Police Department, Longwood Police Department, and Altamonte Springs Police Department to effect service <u>8th</u> day of <u>September</u>, 2008.
