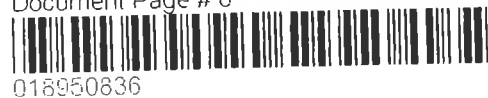
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF INTERIM APPOINTMENT

James Russo Public Defender in and for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida hereby accepts the appointment of the court to represent the defendant in this cause based upon condition that the court in accordance with Florida Statute 27.52 and Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.111(b)(5), placed the accused under oath, made inquiry into the financial status of that person and determined

- 1 The income of the accused is equal to or below 200 percent of the then-current federal poverty guidelines prescribed for the size of the household of the accused by the United States Department of Health and Human Services or the person is unable to pay for the services of an attorney without substantial hardship to his or her family
- 2 The defendant has not been released on bail in the amount of \$5,000.00 or more. The defendant does not own, or have equity in any intangible or tangible personal property or real property or the expectancy of an interest in any such property of substantial monetary value. The defendant did not retain private counsel immediately before or after filing an affidavit of indigency.
- 3 The defendant has been advised to file with the Court a financial affidavit signed under oath and under penalty of perjury containing the factual matters set forth in Florida Statute 27.52(2)(a)
- 4 The defendant has been informed that if the Public Defender is appointed a lien for the services rendered will be imposed by the court pursuant to Florida Statute 938.29
- 5 If this is a prosecution for a misdemeanor, the judge has considered Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.111(b)(1) and the likelihood of imprisonment in the event the defendant is convicted
