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Dear Mrs Reinman,

I've been on High Risk for 11 months on a courtesy hold. The Authority here at Seminole County can only take me off if Brevard ok's it. I haven't been in trouble at all since I've been here or caused any type of problem either. All I ask is for you to okay the decision to put me in General Population, so I can be in a regular dorm like everybody else here and treated fairly. I can't get visits because the High Risk visit days and hours aren't good. My family is at work at these hours, and they won't let me go to church or go to any other Privileged Program because im on High Risk. The Admin Board here said it would be perfectly fine for me to go to General Population, but Brevard's saying no. All I want is a chance to show them i will behave around other people instead of being in isolation like i've been for 11 months. Thank you for hearing that problem
