In accordance with Resolution 2014-219 Section VIII (8.1) the agenda shall provide a section for public comment limited to thirty (30) minutes following approval of the consent agenda during each regular County Commission meeting. Individuals delivering public comment shall be restricted to a three-minute time limit on their presentation.
