ORDER RE: VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHS DEPICTING KILLING

THIS CAUSE came to be heard on August 24, 2012, on a "Motion to Intervene and/or Motion for Protective Order," filed by Attorney Greg Eisenmenger on behalf of Steven Pill, the deceased victim's surviving spouse, and a "Motion to Intervene and Response to Motion to Intervene and/or Motion for Protective Order," filed by Attorney Charles Nash on behalf of Brevard County Sheriff Jack Parker on July 13, 2012. Based on a review of the motions, the official Court file, Judge Crawford's order entered on April 3, 2012, the hearing on August 24, 2012, before the undersigned judge, argument of counsel, authorities cited, and being otherwise fully advised on the premises, it is

ORDERED:



1. Steven Pill and Sheriff Parker are allowed to intervene in this matter regarding the depiction of the killing of Deputy Barbara Pill.

2. The Court adopts Judge Charlie Crawford's Order entered on April 3, 2012, in its entirety in both of the above-styled case numbers.

3. The Court hereby precludes any party to this action and/or any agent of the State of Florida, including but not limited to the Office of the State Attorney and all law enforcement agencies, from disclosing to the public, including media outlets, the video captured by the camera mounted in Deputy Barbara Pill's patrol vehicle, the video captured by the camera mounted on Deputy Jim Troup's patrol vehicle, the photographs depicting Deputy Barbara Pill at Holmes Regional Center, a part of HealthFirst, and/or audio recordings of law enforcement radio communications that contain communications and noises occurring at the time of the shooting of Deputy Pill.

4. No party to this action, including any attorney, or law firm representing any party, as well as any such attorney or law firm's employees and/or agents of the State of Florida, including but not limited to the Office of the State Attorney and all law enforcement agencies shall disclose to the public, including media outlets, the stills from the videos or audio recordings referenced above.

5. Any party to this action, and/or agent of the State of Florida, including but not limited to the Office of the State Attorney and all law enforcement agencies may publicly comment on the content of the videos and photographs outlined above where necessary to further the ongoing criminal investigation subject to the ethical rules for the entities involved.
