HISTORIC BREVARD

Joe Wickham was born in Ames, Iowa, December 20, 1911. After graduating from Eau Gallie High School in 1929, he surveyed the untouched land of Merritt Island and the beaches. Wickham worked with the U.S. Coastal Geodetic Service and for the Guerin Construction Company, where he became a partner; and he formed the Wickham and Jessup Construction Company. During World War II, he was construction superintendent for the Melbourne Air Station and a construction officer in the South Pacific. After the war, Wickham became the largest construction company in Brevard County. In 1947, he was elected Councilman for Eau Gallie; and in 1952 he was elected to the Brevard County Commission, where he served for 24 years. He established the county's first mosquito control program and solid waste program. Wickham Park was named in his honor. Joe Wickham died in 2000. His Great Floridian plaque is located at the Eau Gallie Civic Center, 1551 Highland Avenue, Melbourne.
