

Your Honor:

We are in receipt of the October 8, 2013 letter sent to you by opposing counsel and attaching a proposed Order on Foley & Lardner LLP's Motion to Withdraw as Counsel, a copy of which is attached hereto. Plaintiff does not object to Defendant's counsel being permitted to withdraw, to the Defendant being given 30 days to obtain new counsel, or to the direction of future pleadings to the Defendant at the address specified in the Order. 
