IN RE: CRIMINAL - TRANSPORT OF PRISONERS FROM CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO COURTHOUSE

This action is taken in order to set a uniform policy regulating the transport of prisoners from the John E. Polk Correctional Facility to the Seminole County Courthouse for appearance at proceedings in the Circuit Court Criminal Division.

IT IS ADJUDGED:

- The following proceedings shall be scheduled on dockets with hearings at the John E. Polk Correctional Facility:
 - a. Arraignments.
 - b. Sentencings.
 - c. Violations of Probation or Community Control.
 - d. Bond motions scheduled during hearing weeks.
- 2. Prisoners may be transported from the John E. Polk Correctional Facility to the courthouse only for the following reasons:
 - a. Trials.
 - b. Evidentiary hearings such as a motion to suppress, motion for restitution, or hearings on violation of probation or community control.
 - c. Sentencings which require numerous victims or other witnesses to speak or which will take more that 45 minutes due to the complexity of issues.
 - d. Bond motions scheduled during trial weeks.
 - e. Proceedings which are specifically scheduled by the presiding judge.

- 3. The Sheriff is directed to monitor the number of prisoners requested to be transported on each day and to notify the Criminal Division Administrative Judge if the number exceeds authorized capacity or if special risks are involved.
- 4. The Criminal Division Administrative Judge shall arrange the schedules of the judges in the Criminal Division to allow maximum utilization of the court facilities at the John E. Polk Correctional Facility.
