1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 THE COURT: Mr. Pirrolo, do you want to address Mr.  
3 Bradley?

4 MR. PIRROLO: Yes, we can, Judge. Believe a  
5 continuance will be charged to the State.

6 MR. McMASTER: That's fine, Judge. We'll let it  
7 over to the next docket sounding. State just received  
8 the discovery yesterday.

9 THE COURT: Okay. Hold on one second, let me get to  
10 it.

11 Okay. Mr. Brandon Bradley has one, two, three,  
12 four cases on the docket.

13 MR. PIRROLO: I believe three are VOPs.

14 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: I think Mr. Chauvin was going  
15 to address the VOPs. I think those are his cases.

16 MR. PIRROLO: Yeah, the first three are the VOPs.

17 THE COURT: I told Judge Dugan that he can move the  
18 VOPs over here, so --

19 MR. PIRROLO: Okay.

20 THE COURT: Okay. So, we're just going to address  
21 Case Number 12-35337?

22 MR. PIRROLO: Correct.

23 THE COURT: Okay. And where it's going to be a  
24 continuance charged to the State?

25 MR. McMASTER: That's correct.  
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1 THE COURT: Waive the appearance. State  
2 continuance. What docket sounding?

3 MR. McMASTER: 6/20, Judge.

4 THE COURT: Set it for June the 20th, 2012, at 9:00  
5 a.m.

6 Now, I want to make sure that I announce on the  
7 record that I do not want any hearings set in front of  
8 any other Judge without my approval.

9 MR. PIRROLO: That's fine, Judge.

10 THE COURT: Okay. That hearing did not have my  
11 approval.

12 MR. PIRROLO: I understand. We were in a very deep  
13 time crunch.

14 THE COURT: Okay. Well, still, even when I'm on  
15 vacation and out of the country, I check my emails  
16 everyday. So, someone could have sent me an email and  
17 let me know what was going on. So, I would have  
18 responded.

19 Even if Ms. Billie's not here, I check my emails  
20 everyday.

21 MR. PIRROLO: Okay. Judge, while we're addressing  
22 it, I believe Mr. Chauvin doesn't have the VOP cases for  
23 Mr. Bradley, so I know Ms. Hicks in Judge Dugan's  
24 division had the VOPs. If they are coming here --

25 THE COURT: I talked to Mr. -- I mean, I talked to  
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1 Judge Dugan and I agreed -- normally you wouldn't  
2 transfer the VOPs, but I agreed to transfer them because  
3 he had talked to the State Attorney and the Public  
4 Defender in his division and they have said nothing was  
5 going to happen on the VOPs until the substantive case  
6 was resolved, was his understanding --

7 MR. PIRROLO: Makes sense.

8 THE COURT: And he said instead of just letting it  
9 drag along, I said, just let it drag along with my  
10 cases.

11 MR. PIRROLO: Can we then take the VOPs and put them  
12 on the same docket sounding --

13 THE COURT: I think that would be appropriate.

14 MR. PIRROLO: Okay.

15 THE COURT: So, I'll waive his appearance. Just for  
16 lack of other, I'll make that a Defense continuance, but  
17 it doesn't really matter.

18 MR. PIRROLO: For the VOPs, yes, just so --

19 THE COURT: For the VOPs.

20 MR. PIRROLO: -- the record can be clear, just the  
21 VOPs Defense continuance.

22 THE COURT: And we'll set it for docket sounding,  
23 all three of them for June the 20th, 2012, at 9:00 a.m.

24 MR. PIRROLO: Very good. Thank you, Judge.

25 THE COURT: Okay. Thank you, sir.

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MR. PIRROLO: Have a good day.

THE COURT: You, too.
