1 THE COURT: Mr. Moore.

2 MR. MOORE: I have one Defendant with multiple
3 cases, 19 through 23, Brandon Bradley.

4 THE COURT: Okay. Yes, sir.

5 MR. MOORE: Number 23 is a first-degree murder case.
6 I just got discovery about three weeks ago, I think,
7 still trickling in.

8 I would suggest two docket continuances. We would
9 waive speedy, we haven't waived it. I consulted Mr.
10 Bradley about waiving it and he agreed.

11 THE COURT: Any objection by the State?

12 MR. McMASTER: No, Your Honor.

13 THE COURT: Okay. Be a waive his appearance, he's
14 in custody. Defense continuance granted. Waiver of
15 speedy trial. Set it for docket sounding. If I do two,
16 that's October 3rd. Set it for October the 3rd, 2012,
17 at 9:00 a.m.

18 MR. MOORE: As to the other two substantive cases, I
19 think they're set for calendar call August 1. I haven't
20 had a chance to look at them. I've been focusing on the
21 other first-degree murder case that was set for a time
22 certain under demand for this last Monday, Akeem
23 Robinson, and he just pled, so now I can turn my
24 attention to the other cases.

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1 I'm going to be trying Mr. Alvarez starting August
2 the 6th with George McCarthy, which is a first-degree
3 murder case, and so I would ask that those be continued,
4 as well, those two substantive cases.

5 THE COURT: You say two substantive cases. I show
6 violation of probation -- I show one, two, three
7 violations of probation and then one other substantive.

8 MR. MOORE: That one substantive was it, that's what
9 we're talking about.

10 THE COURT: Okay. Any objection?

11 MR. McMASTER: No objection to carrying those,
12 Judge.

13 THE COURT: So, it will be -- on all of them, just
14 set them all for continuance on all of them, set them
15 for that docket sounding October the 3rd?

16 MR. MOORE: That's my request, yes.

17 THE COURT: Okay. Any objection by the State?

18 MR. McMASTER: No, Your Honor, that's fine.

19 THE COURT: Okay. Well, he's in custody. Defense
20 continuance. Set all the cases for docket sounding
21 October the 3rd, 2012, at 9:00 a.m.

22 MR. MOORE: And that's the VOPs, they're based in
23 part on the first-degree murder case, so I'd ask that
24 they go with the murder case.

25 THE COURT: I've got the three VOPs and the two
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1 substantives and they're all going to October the 3rd.

2 MR. McMASTER: Judge, the other substantive case is
3 actually set for docket sounding on August 1st. There
4 was not a waiver on that case previously, so it would
5 have to be with waiver to continue that one.

6 MR. MOORE: Then, that's what we'll do. Waive
7 speedy and move to continue that, as well.

8 THE COURT: You said docket sounding; it's set for
9 calendar call, so I don't have that on my docket for
10 today. So, if we could just address that that day, so I
11 don't drive them crazy. I don't have any objection to
12 it going to October the 3rd with a waiver, but I'll need
13 to address that that day.

14 MR. MOORE: Let's just do that.

15 THE COURT: I don't want to address something that's
16 not on the docket for today.

17 MR. MOORE: I understand. August 1st.

18 THE COURT: Yeah. With 200-and-something cases
19 today, I don't want to make them stop what's not on the
20 docket for today.

21 MR. MOORE: Sure.

22 THE COURT: Okay. Thank you.


