

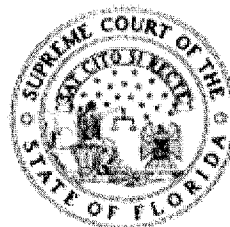

As grounds, Appellant states:
