HISTORIC BREVARD

The Navy's World War II program of spraying for mosquitoes at Banana River AFS provided the inspiration and impetus for Brevard County's' mosquito control program, when naval aviator and County Commissioner Arthur A. Dunn envisioned a similar system of aerial spraying to control the pests. His successor on the board, Joe Wickham, took the reins after him and helped to develop this program, which continues today.
