

NOTICE OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION WITHIN COURT FILINGS

Effective October 1, 2010, attorneys and pro se litigants (people representing themselves without an attorney) are required to complete a "Notice of Confidential Information with Court Filings".

Florida Rules of Judicial Administration 2.420 introduces the requirement for the filer of court documents to identify for the Clerk any confidential information and state where in the document the information is located. The form is part of Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420. It must be filed with any court filings that contain confidential information.

The completion of the "Notice of Confidential Information Within Court Filings" form gives the Clerk the ability to easily locate and redact the confidential information prior to the document becoming public record or being accessed online.
